

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

2 SAFETY

2.1 SIGNAL WORDS EXPLANATION

2.3 GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- $Do \ not \ use \ the \ product \ if \ light sources \ are \ missing \ or \ damaged. \ Dispose \ of \ the \ product \ immediately.$
- Do not use the product without all gaskets in place.
- This product can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the product in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the product.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision

2.4 Additional safety instructions

5.1 Using the product

- Connect the stake to the pole.
- Slide the solar panel onto the pole
- Press the **ON/OFF** button on the back of the solar panel to switch on the product. The first mode is active. Press the MODE button to change to the next mode. The product has 8 modes.

 STEADY ON -> COMBINATION -> WAVES -> SEQUENTIAL -> SLO-GLO -> CHASING/FLASH -> SLOW FADE -> TWINKLE/FLASH
- To switch off the product, press the **ON/OFF** button on the back of the solar panel.

6 CLEANING AND CARE

6.1 CLEANING

⚠ WARNING! RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!

» During cleaning, do not immerse the product, the cord or its plug in water or other liquids. Never hold the product under running water

CAUTION! RISK OF DAMAGE!

- Do not use any aggressive cleaners, brushes with metal or nylon bristles, or sharp or metallic cleaning utensils such as knives, hard scrapers and the like. These could damage the surfaces of the product.
- 1. Wipe the product clean with a damp cloth. Apply a small amount of mild detergent for stubborn dirt as needed.
- Let all parts dry completely.

6.2 STORAGE

- Dry the product completely before storage.
- Always store the product in a dry and cool place, at an ambient room temperature
- Store the product out of reach from children and pets.
