1 GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 READING AND STORING THE USER MANUAL



This user manual belongs to this rechargeable LED spot light, hereinafter also referred to as the product. It contains important information on how to set up and use the product.

Read the user manual carefully, in particular the safety instructions, before using the product. Failure to follow this user manual may lead to severe injuries or product damage.

Keep this user manual for future reference. If you pass this product on to a third party, you must also supply this user manual.

2 SAFETY

The following signal words are used in this user manual.

WARNING!

2.1 EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS

The following symbols are used in this user manual, on the product or on the packaging.



The RCM Mark (Regulatory Compliance Mark) indicates that the product complies with the relevant guidelines of the ACMA as well as corresponding government requirements for the safety of electrical devices.



The product meets the specifications of protection class III and is operated with safety extra-low voltage.

IP44

The product is protected against penetrating foreign objects with a diameter of ≥ 1 mm and it is splashproof from all directions.

2.2 SAFETY NOTES

WARNING!

Risk of electric shock!

Faulty electric installation or excess voltage can cause an electric shock.

- » Only connect the power cable if the voltage of the voltage source matches the information shown on the rating plate.
- » The product must only be operated with extra low voltage (in line with the class III marking on the product).

WARNING!

Danger to children and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental abilities (e.g. partially disabled, elderly people with reduced physical and mental abilities) or lack of experience and knowledge (e.g. older children).

- » This product can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the product in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- » Do not leave the product unattended when in use.

The light of the LEDs is very bright and can damage your eyes when looking directly at them.

- » Do not look directly into the light of the LEDs.
- » Do not look at the LEDs with an optical instrument while the product is in operation.

CAUTION!

Risk of damage!

Improper assembly can damage the product.

- » Charge the product once the light output decreases to prevent the battery from suffering a deep discharge.
- » Operate the product on an easily accessible, level, dry, heat resistant and sufficiently stable work surface. Never place the product on the edge of the work surface.
- » Never place the product on or near hot surfaces (stove tops, etc.) and never expose the product to high temperatures (heaters, etc.) or to bad weather (rain, etc.).
- » Never immerse the product in water to clean it, and do not use a steam cleaner. This can damage the product.
- » Stop using the product if any of its components are cracked or deformed. Only replace damaged components with matching original spare parts.
- » Do not attempt to repair or modify the product yourself. Have repairs carried out by trained personnel.

2.3 SAFETY NOTES FOR BATTERIES

CAUTION!

Risk of explosion!

- » Never short-circuit the battery.
- » Never open the battery.
- » Do not throw the battery into a fire.
- » Only charge the product via the supplied USB cable on a suitable USB charger or via the USB port on a computer.
- » Charge the battery at room temperature.
- » This product contains batteries that cannot be replaced. Correctly dispose of the product once the battery has reached the end of its service life.

CAUTION!

Risk of chemical burns!

- » Never open the battery.
- » If battery fluid leaks out, avoid contact with the skin, eyes and mucus membranes. Rinse the affected region immediately with plenty of clear water and contact a physician immediately.
- » Wear protective gloves in case of a leaky battery.

- » If the battery is defective, the complete product must be disposed of correctly.

2.4 PROPER USE

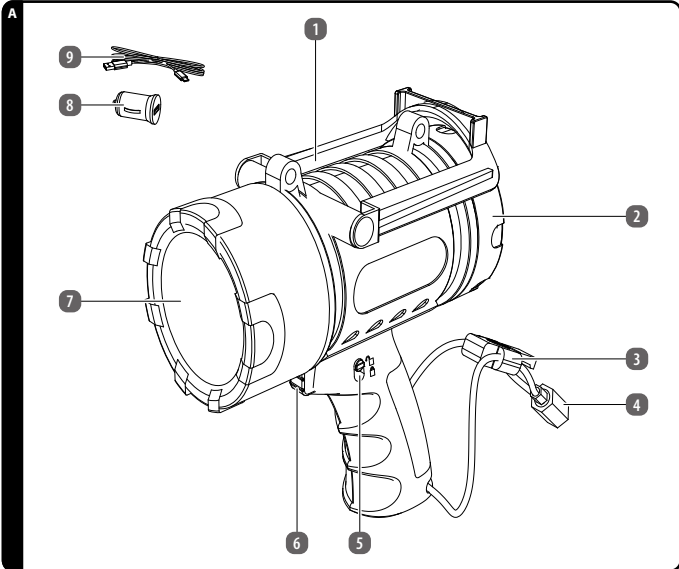
The product is exclusively intended for lighting indoor and outdoor workspaces. The product is not suitable as a reading light.

It is only intended for private indoor use and not suitable for commercial purposes.

Only use the product as described in this user manual. Any other use is considered improper and may result in damage to property or persons. The product is not a children's toy.

The manufacturer or vendor cannot be held liable for damages or injury incurred through improper or incorrect use.

4 BEFORE FIRST USE

4.1 CHECK THE PRODUCT AND SCOPE OF DELIVERY

CAUTION!

Risk of damage!

If opening the packaging with a sharp knife or other pointed object, be careful to avoid damaging the product's surface.

- » Proceed carefully with opening the packaging.

1. Take the product out of the packaging.
2. Check that the delivery is complete (see chapter ^{***}).
3. Inspect the product and individual parts for damage. Do not operate a damaged product, instead, contact the manufacturer via the service center listed on the warranty card.

4.2 CHARGING THE PRODUCT

CAUTION!

Risk of damage!

Charging the car battery with a charger can damage the product.

- » Switch off the product and disconnect the vehicle connection cable from the cigarette lighter socket before charging your vehicle battery with a charger.

CAUTION!

The vehicle battery is under load!

When operating on a cigarette lighter socket, the capacity of the vehicle battery may be impaired and the vehicle may no longer start.

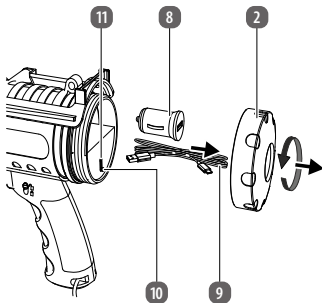
- » Do not use the product if your vehicle battery is low.
- » Only use the product for short periods when the vehicle engine is switched off.
- » If necessary, equip your vehicle with voltage protection or an additional battery.

Fully charge the battery before using the product for the first time. Only use the USB connection cable **9** located behind the cover **2** and / or the car adapter **8**. Only charge the product in dry indoor areas or in a car.

NOTE

- » The product cannot be switched on during the charging process, so continuous operation is not possible.

B



1. Unscrew the cover (2) anti-clockwise.
2. Remove the required accessories.
3. Connect the USB connection cable (9) to the USB port (11).
4. Connect the USB connection cable
 - to the USB connection of a power supply unit or
 - to the USB port of the car adapter, after plugging the car adapter into cigarette lighter socket with 12 V DC voltage.
The charging indicator (10) lights up red. The charging indicator lights up green as soon as the product is fully charged.
5. Disconnect the USB connection cable from the USB port of the product and the power supply unit / car adapter.
6. Proceed in reverse order to assemble it.

5 OPERATION

5.1 SWITCHING THE LIGHT ON/OFF AND CHANGING SETTINGS

1. Press the on/off switch (6).
The LED (7) lights up.
2. Release the on/off switch.
The LED is switched off.

The following light modes can be set by pressing the on/off switch several times:

Pressing the button	1	LED lights up (100%)
	2	LED lights up (50%)
	3	SOS
	4	OFF

5.2 TRANSPORT LOCK

1. Slide the lock (5) downwards to secure the product against unintentional switching on.
The transport lock is activated.
2. Slide the lock upwards to deactivate the transport lock.

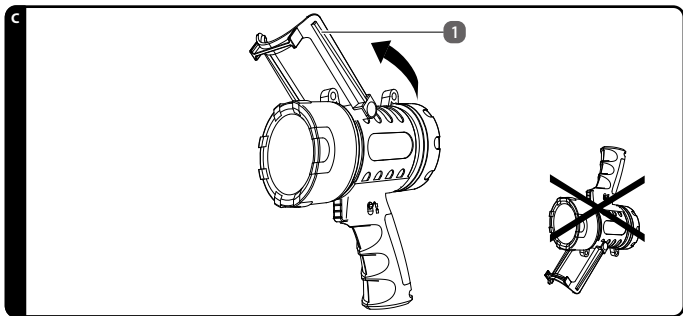
5.3 USE HAND STRAP AND WHISTLE

- Guide the hand strap (4) over your wrist.
The product can now be used and worn safely and comfortably.
- Blow into the whistle (3).
This allows you to draw attention to yourself in emergency situations.

5.4 USING THE HANDLE

NOTE

- » Do not use the handle as a stand.



Fold out the handle (1).

You can carry the product by the handle.

6 CLEANING

CAUTION!

Risk of damage!

Improper handling can damage the product.

- » Do not use any harsh cleaning products, brushes with metal or nylon bristles, or sharp or metallic cleaning materials such as knives, hard scrapers or similar. They may damage the surfaces.

6.1 CLEANING THE DEVICE

Wipe the surfaces down with a dry cloth.

7 INSPECTION

Before each use check that:

- the product is undamaged,
- the controls are not damaged,
- the accessories are in perfect condition.

Do not operate a damaged product or accessory. Instead, have it inspected and repaired by the manufacturer or their customer service or a similarly qualified person.

8 STORAGE

CAUTION!

Risk of damage!

Improper storage of the product can result in damage.

- » Store the product in a clean, dry, frost-protected place out of the reach of children.

All parts must be completely dry before they are put away.

- Always store the product in a dry place.
 - Protect the product from direct sunlight.
 - Store the product out of the reach of children, safely closed, at a storage temperature between +5 °C and +20 °C (room temperature).
1. Thoroughly clean the product (see section "Cleaning").
 2. Roll up the USB cable without knots or bends.

11.1 DISPOSING OF PACKAGING
